Who can enter?

Anyone can put forward a project for a National Crimebeat Award, provided it meets the following criteria:

- It prevents/reduces crime or anti-social behaviour, or supports victims of crime
- It is delivered by young people aged 25 and under, and they are involved in the management of the project

How do I enter?
